Jones, Jr. and others for legislation to establish pregnancy as a qualifying event for eligibility for special enrollment in certain health plans in the state health insurance exchange. Financial Services.

### The Commonwealth of Alassachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-First General Court (2019-2020)

An Act establishing pregnancy as a qualifying event.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, in addition to
- 2 any qualifying event under federal law, rule or regulation that makes one eligible for a special
- 3 enrollment period for enrollment in a qualified health plan in the state health insurance exchange
- 4 established pursuant to the federal patient protection and affordable care act, the state health
- 5 insurance exchange shall allow for the enrollment of a pregnant individual within 30 days
- 6 following the commencement of the pregnancy; provided however, that the pregnancy is
- 7 certified by a licensed health care provider, as defined in chapter 112 of the general laws. Upon
- 8 such enrollment, any qualified health plan in the state health insurance exchange shall ensure that
- 9 coverage is effective on the first day of the month in which said certification is received.
- SECTION 2. This act shall take effect on January 1, 2020.
