Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 14 of chapter 151A of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2014
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the first paragraph, the following
- 3 paragraph:-
- 4 New employers shall be assigned an initial flat rate for the first five years, unless a claim
- 5 is made against their account during the third, fourth or fifth years. If no claims are made during
- 6 the first five years, then the employer shall be assigned a contribution rate pursuant to paragraph
- 7 (1) of subsection (i). If, however, a claims is made in the third, fourth or fifth years, the
- 8 employer shall be assigned a contribution rate pursuant to paragraph (1) of subsection (i) at the
- 9 time the claim is made.
