Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 17N of chapter 32A of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2016
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the word "planning.", in line 10, the
