*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The fourth paragraph of section 87XX1/2 of chapter 112 of the General Laws, as  
2 appearing in the 2008 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting, after the word “licensed”  
3 in line 40, the following words:-

4 nor to a person who was not an attorney at the time of original license issuance but who has  
5 subsequently become an attorney

7 SECTION 2. The fifth paragraph of said section 87XX1/2, as so appearing, is hereby amended  
8 by inserting, after the fifth sentence, the following sentence:-

9 There shall be no obligation to pay any fees, other than an application fee for

10 reactivation, during any period of inactivity.
