Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 2 Edition, is hereby amended by adding, after the first paragraph, the following paragraph:— No
- 3 rule, regulation or provision of law shall prohibit a candidate on the current election ballot from
- 4 greeting voters and soliciting votes within 150 feet of the entrance door to the building where a
- 5 polling place is located, provided that he/she is not distributing campaign material nor
- 6 obstructing voters entering the polls.
