In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court (2015-2016)

An Act relative to level I sex offenders.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1

- 2 Subparagraph (a) of subsection (2) of Section 178K of chapter 6 of the general laws is
- 3 hereby amended by striking the words in sentence 3, and inserting in place thereof, the following
- 4 new sentence:-
- 5 The police shall provide information, upon written application, to the general public at
- 6 the police station identifying the sex offender where the board has classified the individual as a
- 7 level 1 sex offender, but will not publicly distribute said information.
- 8 The police and the board may, however, release such information identifying such sex
- 9 offender to the department of correction, any county correctional facility, the department of
- 10 youth services, the department of children and families, the parole board, the department of
- 11 probation and the department of mental health, all city and town police departments and the
- 12 Federal Bureau of Investigation.
