The Commonwealth of Alassachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-First General Court (2019-2020)

An Act to restore adequate funding for disproportionate share hospitals.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the executive office of health and human services shall include in its reimbursement rates to disproportionate share hospitals as defined under section 8A of chapter 118E an additional 2 percent to its inpatient adjudicated payment amount per discharge and an additional 2 percent to its outpatient adjudicated payment amount per episode of care; provider further, the executive office shall provide a supplemental payment of at least \$10,000,000 for inpatient and outpatient behavioral and mental health services provided by disproportionate share hospitals subject to all required

8 federal approvals and the availability of federal financial participation and shall be prioritized for

9 services provided to children and adolescents.
