An Act Relative to the Safety of School Grounds.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1: Chapter 266 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after  
2 Section 120f the following section:-

3 Section 120G. Trespass on or about School Grounds.

4 (a)It shall be unlawful to trespass or loiter on or about the grounds of any school without  
5 having any reason or relationship involving custody of or responsibility for a pupil or any other  
6 license or privilege to be there.

7 (b) Any person in violation of this statue shall be punished by incarceration in a House of  
8 Correction for not more than six months or a fine of not more than one thousand five hundred  
9 dollars, or both.
