In the One Hundred and Ninety-Second General Court (2021-2022)

An Act relative to increasing patient choice through assignment of benefits.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1	SECTION 1. Section 108B of Chapter 175 of the General Laws, as appearing in the
2	2020 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting at the end of said section the following

3 new paragraph:-

4	Every carrier shall permit, as a provision in a group or individual policy, contract or
5	health plan for coverage of dental services, a covered person to direct in writing that
6	reimbursable benefits for covered dental services be paid directly to the treating dentist
7	irrespective of whether the dentist has contracted with the carrier to provide dental services to
8	covered persons of the carrier. The carrier paying the dentist, pursuant to a direction to pay duly
9	executed by the covered person, shall have the right to review the records of the dentist receiving
10	such payment that relate exclusively to that particular covered person and service provided
11	pursuant to the claim for payment to determine that the service in question is rendered. The

paying carrier shall not pay the dentist who has not contracted with the carrier a different rate orfee than a dentist who has contracted with the carrier for the same services rendered.

14 SECTION 2: Section 7 of chapter 176B of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2020 15 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting at the end thereof the following new paragraph:-16 Every carrier, including but not limited to medical service corporations, shall permit, as a 17 provision in a group or individual policy, contract or health plan for coverage of dental services, 18 a covered person, including subscribers and covered dependents, to direct in writing that 19 reimbursable benefits for covered dental services be paid directly to the treating dentist 20 irrespective of whether the dentist has contracted with the carrier to provide dental services to 21 covered persons of the carrier. The carrier paying the dentist, pursuant to a direction to pay duly 22 executed by the covered person, shall have the right to review the records of the dentist receiving 23 such payment that relate exclusively to that particular covered person and service provided 24 pursuant to the claim for payment to determine that the service in question is rendered. The 25 paying carrier shall not pay the dentist who has not contracted with the carrier a different rate or 26 fee than a dentist who has contracted with the carrier for the same services rendered. 27 SECTION 3: Section 7 of chapter 176E of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2020

Every carrier, including but not limited to dental service corporations, shall permit, as a provision in a group or individual policy, contract or health plan for coverage of dental services, a covered person, including subscribers and covered dependents, to direct in writing that reimbursable benefits for covered dental services be paid directly to the treating dentist irrespective of whether the dentist has contracted with the carrier to provide dental services to

The carrier paying the dentist, pursuant to a direction to pay duly 35 executed by the covered person, shall have the right to review the records of the dentist receiving 36 such payment that relate exclusively to that particular covered person and service provided 37 pursuant to the claim for payment to determine that the service in question is rendered. The 38 paying carrier shall not pay the dentist who has not contracted with the carrier a different rate or 39 fee than a dentist who has contracted with the carrier for the same services rendered.

42 (e) Every carrier, including but not limited to health maintenance organizations, shall 43 permit, as a provision in a group or individual policy, contract or health plan for coverage of 44 dental services, a covered person, including members and enrolled members, to direct in writing 45 that reimbursable benefits for covered dental services be paid directly to the treating dentist 46 irrespective of whether the dentist has contracted with the carrier to provide dental services to 47 covered persons of the carrier. The carrier paying the dentist, pursuant to a direction to pay duly 48 executed by the covered person, shall have the right to review the records of the dentist receiving 49 such payment that relate exclusively to that particular covered person and service provided 50 pursuant to the claim for payment to determine that the service in question is rendered. The 51 paying carrier shall not pay the dentist who has not contracted with the carrier a different rate or 52 fee than a dentist who has contracted with the carrier for the same services rendered.

53 SECTION 5: Section 2 of chapter 176I of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2020
54 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting at the end thereof the following new paragraph:-

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55 Every carrier, including but not limited to organizations, shall permit, as a provision in a 56 group or individual policy, contract or health plan for coverage of dental services, a covered person to direct in writing that reimbursable benefits for covered dental services be paid directly 57 58 to the treating dentist irrespective of whether the dentist has contracted with the carrier to 59 provide dental services to covered persons of the carrier. The carrier paying the dentist, pursuant 60 to a direction to pay duly executed by the covered person, shall have the right to review the 61 records of the dentist receiving such payment that relate exclusively to that particular covered 62 person and service provided pursuant to the claim for payment to determine that the service in 63 question is rendered. The paying carrier shall not pay the dentist who has not contracted with the carrier a different rate or fee than a dentist who has contracted with the carrier for the same 64 65 services rendered.
