### The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court (2015-2016)

An Act improving juror service.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- Section 58 of chapter 234A of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2012 Official
- 2 Edition, is hereby amended by striking out the first sentence and inserting in place thereof the
- 3 following sentences:-¬ The office of jury commissioner shall provide juror service certificates to
- 4 all grand and trial jurors who perform juror service. Such certificates shall be provided no later
- 5 than 14 days after the last business day of each week in which a grand or trial juror performs jury
- 6 service.
