An Act adding retail drive-up curbside pickup for marijuana establishments.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Section 12 of Chapter 94G of the Massachusetts General Laws is hereby amended by  
2 adding a new subsection - :

3           (i) A marijuana establishment may create retail drive-up curbside pickup for the sale of  
4 medical and recreational marijuana, including but not limited to both external and internal  
5 curbside pickup. The establishment must seek approval from the town or city where the  
6 establishment is located. The establishment’s drive-up curbside pickup must be in compliance  
7 with all town or city ordinances regulating drive-up curbside pickup.
