In the One Hundred and Ninety-First General Court (2019-2020)

An Act relative to the endowment match program.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- Section 15E of chapter 15A of the General Laws, as appearing in the official acts of
- 2 2014, is amended by removing the following words in the second paragraph "subject to
- 3 appropriation" and inserting the following after the last paragraph:
- 4 "Not less than \$20,000,000 shall be expended for the purposes of continuing the
- 5 implementation of section 15E of chapter 15A of the General Laws to encourage private
- 6 fundraising by the commonwealth's public institutions of higher education for the endowment
- 7 and capital outlay programs of those institutions; provided further, that the board of higher
- 8 education shall implement this program in a manner which ensures that each institution shall
- 9 have an opportunity to secure matching funds from this item; provided further, that \$10,000,000
- shall be allocated to the university of Massachusetts; provided further, that \$5,000,000 shall be

allocated to state universities; provided further, that \$5,000,000 shall be allocated to community colleges; provided further, that if any funds allocated herein for disbursement to community colleges shall be unused, the remaining funds shall be made available to the state universities; provided further, that if any funds allocated herein for disbursement to state universities shall be unused, the remaining funds shall be made available to the university of Massachusetts; provided further, that, to the extent possible, the state universities, community colleges, and the university of Massachusetts shall utilize the funds to increase the number of scholarship opportunities for students;"
