The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court (2015-2016)

An Act relative to the appointment of private counsel.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 11 of chapter 211D of the General Laws as appearing in the 2012
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out the first sentence and inserting in place
- 3 thereof the following new sentence:—
- 4 The rates of compensation payable to all counsel, who are appointed or assigned to
- 5 represent indigents within the private counsel division of the committee in accordance with the
- 6 provisions of paragraph (b) of section 6, shall, subject to appropriation, be as follows: for
- 7 homicide cases the rate of compensation shall be \$140 per hour; for superior court non-homicide
- 8 cases, including sexually dangerous person cases, the rate of compensation shall be \$100 per
- 9 hour; for district court cases, children in need of services cases, children and family law cases,
- 10 care and protection cases, sex offender registry cases and mental health cases the rate of
- 11 compensation shall be \$75 per hour.
- SECTION 2. Section 11 of chapter 211D of the General Laws, as so appearing, is hereby
- 13 amended by striking out the last paragraph.
