1 Resolved, That notwithstanding any General or Special Law to the contrary there is

hereby established a Special Commission to investigate and make recommendations to the

General Court concerning the use of manufactured wood products and light weight wood frame

truss assemblies so called. Such investigation shall study the inordinate number of firefighter

5 deaths and injuries in this construction type, the impact these type building products will have on

6 fire insurance rates in the Commonwealth, whether full disclosure to home buyers detailing the

7 fire resistive qualities of these products compared to dimension lumber construction should be

mandated and what steps should be taken to mitigate any problems associated with these
