An Act relative to the enhancement of child safety .

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 AN ACT Related to the Enhancement of Public Safety of Children in the Vicinity of an
2 Attractive Nuisance , a Motor Vehicle with the Purpose of Selling Frozen Desserts.

3 SECTION 1. Chapter 101 section 16A of the General Laws is hereby amended by
4 inserting the following new section:

5 Section 2. If a motor vehicle is stopped on a road for the purpose of selling frozen
6 desserts without a functioning and operating amber dome light, or front and rear warning lights,
7 said vehicle shall be subject to a citation and fine of one hundred dollars to be issued by any law
8 enforcement officer.
