## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Thirteen

An Act to increase the wages of private sector human service workers .

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 257 of the Acts of 2008 is amended in Section 4 by inserting after the words 2 "those attributed to inflation;" the following words:-
- 3 the cost of bringing the lowest funded position up to 125% of the living wage, as defined
- 4 by the Massachusetts Institute of Technology living wage calculator, for a single person, for the
- 5 area where the program is funded and corresponding increases to other positions which are also
- 6 below the living wage as defined by the Massachusetts Institute of Technology living wage
- 7 calculator.
