#### The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court (2015-2016)

An Act relative to public health volunteer responders.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 111 of the General Laws, is hereby amended by inserting after Section 25P the
- 2 following section:-
- 3 SECTION 25Q. All Massachusetts medical reserve corps volunteers shall demonstrate
- 4 proof of medical insurance coverage as required by Massachusetts law. In the absence of any
- 5 other protections provided by law, whenever activated for duty, members of the voluntary
- 6 registry shall not incur any personal liability for the medical costs incurred for any injuries
- 7 sustained as a result of good faith acts or omissions in the performance of their duties.
