Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- Paragraph (g) of subdivision (2) of section 3 of chapter 32 of the General Laws, is hereby
- 2 amended by inserting after line 326 the following new paragraph:-

- Any public authority with employees who are members of a retirement system
- 4 independent of the Massachusetts State Retirement System and the Massachusetts Teachers
- 5 Retirement System may elect to improve the retirement group classification for any group of
- 6 employees by a majority vote of the authority governing board. Nothing in this act shall be
- 7 construed as authorization to diminish the retirement benefits of public employees by placing
- 8 any group of employees in a lower group of classification.
