## AN ACT RELATIVE TO ABANDONED PROPERTY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 3 of Chapter 200A of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2006 Official Edition,
- 2 is hereby amended by inserting after line 28 the following new sub paragraph:

- 4 (7) For the purposes of this section, a record of the sending of an Internal Revenue Service Form 1099
- 5 INT, or its equivalent, to the persons enumerated in this section and a record of its not being returned by
- 6 the United States Postal Service or its successor, shall be an indication of interest.
- 7 SECTION 2.
- 8 Section 1 of Chapter 260 of the General Laws, as so appearing, is hereby amended by striking out section
- 9 1 and inserting in place thereof the following:
- 10 Section 1. The following actions shall be commenced only within twenty years next after the cause of
- 11 action accrues:
- 12 First, Actions upon contracts under seal.
- Second, Actions upon promissory notes signed in the presence of an attesting witness, if brought by the
- original payee or by his executor or administrator.
- 15 Third, Actions upon contracts not limited by the following section or by any other law.
- Fourth, Actions under section thirty-two of chapter one hundred and twenty-three to recover for the

- SECTION 3. Section 2 of Chapter 260 of the General Laws, as so appearing, is hereby amended by
- inserting after the word "States" in line 5, the words "and actions upon bills, notes or other evidences of
- 20 indebtedness issued by a bank."
