# The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-First General Court (2019-2020)

An Act relative to assault and battery on public employees.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:* 

1	SECTION 1. Section 13D of Chapter 265 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2016
2	Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out the first paragraph and inserting in place
3	thereof the following paragraph:-
4	Section 13D. Whoever commits an assault and battery upon any public employee when
5	such person is engaged in the performance of his duties at the time of such assault and battery,
6	shall be punished by imprisonment in the house of correction for not more than 2 $1/2$ years or by
7	imprisonment in the state prison for not more than 5 years or by a fine of not less than \$1,000 nor
8	more than \$10,000.

9 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
