An Act protecting public higher education student information.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 66 of the General Laws is amended by adding at the end a new section:

2 Section 22: Public colleges and universities as defined in Section 5 of Chapter 15A shall  
3 not be required to produce records defined as education records in the Family Education Rights  
4 and Privacy Act (20 USC 11232g) at 34 CFR § 99.3, including those education records  
5 designated by the public colleges and universities as directory information as defined in FERPA  
6 at 34 CFR § 99.3.
