An Act relative to the retirement classification of Boston school police officers.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 3 of chapter 32 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2014  
2   Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the word “powers”, in line 257, the  
3   following words:- Boston school police officers.

4           SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
