The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-Second General Court (2021-2022)

An Act relative to senior and non-elderly disabled housing.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Within 45 days after the effective date of this act, a 15-member advisory
 commission shall be established to study the best practices and safety protocols of state
- 3 subsidized senior and non-elderly disabled housing. The advisory committee shall consist of the
- 4 following members: two members selected by the Governor of the Commonwealth; four
- 5 members selected by the Speaker of the House; four members selected by the Senate President;
- 6 one member selected by the Citizens Housing and Planning Association; one member selected
- 7 by the Massachusetts Chapter of the National Association of Housing and Redevelopment
- 8 Officials; one member selected by the Mass Union of Public Housing Tenants; one member
- 9 selected by the Disability Law Center; one member selected by the Massachusetts Municipal
- 10 Association.
