AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE ENFORCEMENT OF CHILD ABUSE REPORTING REQUIREMENTS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority
of the same, as follows:*

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 119 § 51A of the 2004 Official Edition of the General Laws is hereby amended in
- 2 line 46 by striking out the words “one thousand dollars” and inserting in place thereof the following
- 3 words: “twenty-five thousand dollars or by imprisonment in the House of Corrections for not more than
- 4 two and one half years, or both such fine and imprisonment.”
- 5 SECTION 2. Chapter 119 § 51A of the General Laws is hereby amended in line 48 by striking out the
- 6 words “one thousand dollars” and inserting in place thereof the following words: “twenty-five thousand
- 7 dollars or by imprisonment in the House of Corrections for not more than two and one half years, or both
- 8 such fine and imprisonment.”
