AN ACT RELATIVE TO SUBSEQUENT CONVICTIONS FOR ASSAULT AND BATTERY ON A POLICE OFFICER.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 13D of Chapter 265 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2004 Official
- 2 Edition, is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof the following language:—
- 3 A second and subsequent conviction under this section shall be punished by imprisonment for not less
- 4 than 120 days nor more than 2½ years in a house of correction or by a fine of not less than one thousand
- 5 dollars nor more than ten thousand dollars, or both. A third and subsequent conviction under this section
- 6 shall be punished by imprisonment for not less than one year in a house of correction nor more than 3
- years in state prison or by a fine of not less than two thousand dollars nor more than ten thousand dollars,
- 8 or both.
