An Act establishing the workforce training trust fund

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Subsection (a) of section 2RR of chapter 29 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2008
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the word “Training”, in line 3 the
- 3 following word:- Trust. Subsection (b) of said section 2RR of said chapter 29, as so appearing,
- 4 is hereby amended by striking out, in line 6, the words:- “Subject to appropriation,”. Said
- 5 subsection (b) of said section 2RR of said chapter 29, as so appearing is hereby amended by
- 6 inserting after the word “Fund”, in line 8, the following words:-, without prior appropriation,.
- 7 Sections 3A, 20A, 21, 21A and 25 of chapter 175 of the Acts of 1998 are hereby repealed.
- 8 Section 1 of chapter 172 of the Acts of 1999 is hereby repealed.
- 9 Section 159 of chapter 184 of the Acts of 2002 is hereby repealed.
- 10 Section 8 of chapter 45 of the Acts of 2005 is hereby repealed.

11 Section 78 of chapter 123 of the Acts of 2006 is hereby repealed.
