# The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Thirteen

An Act relative to the enticement of children online.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 26C of chapter 265 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2010

2 Official Edition, is hereby amended, in line 2, by inserting after the word "invite" the following

3 words:-- by any means, including but not limited to: personal contact, postal mail, telephone,

4 instant electronic messaging and electronic mail.
