Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 113 of Chapter 58 of the Acts of 2006 is hereby amended by inserting
- 2 after the first sentence the following sentence:-
- 3 The terms and conditions of contracts, including financial arrangements, between any managed
- 4 care organization and any specialty behavioral health managed care organization shall be subject
- 5 to section 10 of Chapter 66 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2008 Official Edition.
