An Act to update expungement.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Chapter 276 of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking out section  
2   100Q, inserted by section 195 of chapter 69 of the acts of 2018, and inserting in place thereof the  
3   following section:-

4           100Q. Unless otherwise provided by law, no person shall make records sealed pursuant to  
5   section 100A, section 100B or section 100C available for inspection in any form by any person.  
6   No person shall make records expunged pursuant to section 100F, section 100G, section 100H or  
7   section 100K available for inspection in any form by any person.

8           SECTION 2. Section 100T of Chapter 276 of the General Laws, as so appearing, is  
9   hereby amended by striking out, in line 1, the words “100A or section 100B” and inserting in  
10   place thereof the words:- 100A, 100B or 100C”.
