AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE PRACTICE OF LAW.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 221 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2002 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding
2 the following new section:—
3 Section 46E. The provisions of section 46 shall not apply to a corporation, or its agents, which has been organized
4 under the provisions of chapter 156 as a corporation, in the performance by such corporation, or its agents of
5 drafting deeds, mortgages, leases and agreements in connection with sales or leases made or negotiated, in
6 examining the title and removing exceptions to such title, in representing lenders as their closing agents and in
7 issuing title certification or policy of title insurance premised on evaluation of title to real estate.
