An Act relative to equity in education funding.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 3 of chapter 70 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2008 Official
- 2 Edition, is hereby amended by adding the following paragraph:
- 3 Any municipality with a combined effort yield of 100 per cent or greater of the fiscal year 2012
- 4 foundation budget and each ensuing year, shall have in fiscal year 2012 and in each ensuing year
- 5 a target maximum local contribution of no more than 82.5 per cent of its foundation budget.
- 6 Any municipality with a combined effort yield less than 100 per cent of the fiscal year 2012
- 7 foundation budget and each ensuing year, shall have in fiscal year 2012 and in each ensuing year
- 8 a target maximum local contribution of no more than 80 per cent of its foundation budget.
