An Act relative to Title 5 income tax credit reform.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 6(i) of Chapter 62 of the General Laws, as so appearing in the 2008 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking in line 198 the figure " $\$ 15,000$ " and inserting in place thereof the following:-- " $\$ 25,000$ "; and, by striking in line 201 the figure " $\$ 1,500$ " and inserting in place thereof the following:-- " $\$ 4,000$ "; and by striking in line 203 the figure " $\$ 6,000 "$ and inserting in place thereof the following:-- " $\$ 10,000 . "$
