RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY RELATIVE TO THE NOTIFICATION BY THE DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTION OF THE RELEASE OF CERTAIN INMATES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

Resolved,

That a special commission, to consist of two members of the senate, four members of the house of representatives and three members to be appointed by the governor, is hereby established for the purpose of making an investigation and study relative to the feasibility of requiring the department of correction to provide notice of the release of any inmate to the appropriate local police departments and any other appropriate persons.
