An Act relative to the head injury treatment services trust fund.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 59 of Chapter 10 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2018
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out the word "and", in line 4, and inserting after
- 3 the figure "24", in line 4, the following words:- and Section 13B"
- 4 SECTION 2. Section 13B(b) of Chapter 90 of the General Laws, as appearing in the
- 5 2018 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding, after the word "offense" the following
- 6 words: -

There shall be an assessment of \$250 against a person who is convicted of, is placed on probation for, or is granted a continuance without a finding for or otherwise pleads guilty to or admits to a finding of sufficient facts of operating a motor vehicle while under the influence of intoxicating liquor, marijuana, narcotic drugs, depressants or stimulant substances under this section; provided, however, that 100 per cent of the amount collected under this assessment shall be deposited monthly by the court with the state treasurer for who shall deposit it into the Head Injury Treatment Services Trust Fund.
