Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 14 of chapter 269 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2020

2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting in line 15, at the beginning of paragraph (1), the

3 following:— to behead persons at a place or location; or

4 SECTION 2. Said section 14 of said chapter 269 of the General Laws, as so appearing, is

- 5 hereby further amended by inserting in line 30, after the word "threat", the following:, or
- 6 knowingly communicates a false report of an active shooting at a school,
