### The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court (2015-2016)

An Act relative to assaults upon sports officials.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1.
- 2 Chapter 265 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after section 13D½ the
- 3 following section: —
- 4 Section XX Whoever commits an assault upon a sports official within the confines or
- 5 immediate vicinity of the athletic facility at which the athletic contest in which said official
- 6 officiated shall be punished by imprisonment for not more than two and one-half years in a house
- 7 of correction or by a fine of not more than ten thousand dollars.
