## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court (2015-2016)

An Act providing further penalties for intentional loss or damage to a gravestone or other gravemarker.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 73 of chapter 272 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2008
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding the following sentence:- In addition, the court
- 3 shall order the defendant to pay restitution to the owner of the property damaged, destroyed,
- 4 mutilated, defaced, inured or removed.
