An Act authorizing and directing the Teacher’s Retirement Board to permit Henry McDeed to elect into the alternative superannuation retirement benefit program

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the Massachusetts teachers'
- 2 retirement board is hereby authorized and directed to allow Mr. Henry McDeed, a school teacher
- 3 and an active member of the teachers' retirement system to elect into the alternative
- 4 superannuation retirement benefit program; provided that said Henry McDeed shall make
- 5 retirement contributions to the system as if he had elected into said program on or before July 1,
- 6 2001, plus buyback interest.
