## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-Third General Court (2023-2024)

An Act clarifying insurance liability for foster care providers.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:* 

1 Chapter 119 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after section 33C the

2 following new section:-

3 INSURANCE LIABILITY FOR FOSTER CARE PROVIDERS.

4 Providers of foster care services for children and/or youth contracted by the state's

5 Department of Children and Families shall not be held liable for injury to persons or damage to

6 property caused by negligence or other action(s) or inaction(s) of the state or its employees or

7 other third parties.
