- 1 An Act relative to judgment for alimony.
- 2 SECTION 1. Section 34 of chapter 208 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2012
- 3 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out, in line 1, the words “at any time” and
- 4 inserting in place thereof: -within 1 year.
