In the One Hundred and Ninety-Second General Court (2021-2022)

An Act relative to veterans and habitual offenders.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 25 of Chapter 279 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2018 Official Edition,
- 2 is hereby amended in line (...) of subsection (a) by inserting after the words "provided by law"
- 3 the words:-"No sentence imposed under this subsection shall be reduced or suspended nor shall
- 4 such person so sentenced be eligible for probation, parole, work release or furlough or receive
- 5 any deduction from such person's sentence for good conduct."
