An Act Relative to CORI fees.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 172A of Chapter 6 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2018
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting, in line 6, after the word “chapter 258B,” the
3 following:-

4 “or for a request made by a parent or legal guardian or legal custodian for the criminal
5 record information of a childcare provider who has or may have direct contact with a child of
6 such parent or a child under the care of such legal guardian or legal custodian,”
