**In the One Hundred and Ninetieth General Court
(2017-2018)**

An Act relative to access of business licenses.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 66 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after
2 section 5A, the following section:-

3 Section 5B. Limited liability entities and business and nonprofit corporations organized
4 or registered to do business in the Commonwealth, shall keep all local, state and federally issued
5 operating licenses in a binder that shall be made readily accessible to the public upon verbal
6 request during normal hours of operation.
