## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court (2015-2016)

An Act regarding youth sports referees.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Chapter 149 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after
- 2 section 191 the following section:-
- 3 SECTION 192. A boy or girl over 11 years of age and less than 14 years may be
- 4 employed in any city or town as a youth athletic program referee, umpire, or official for an age
- 5 bracket younger or equal to the minor's own age; provided, however, that an adult representing
- 6 the state or local athletic program is on the premises at which the athletic program event is
- 7 occurring; provided, further, that a person responsible for the state or local athletic program
- 8 possesses a written acknowledgment signed by the minor's parent or guardian consenting to the
- 9 minor's employment as a referee, umpire, or official; provided, further, that the employer
- 10 provides the boy or girl with written policies regarding the activities and responsibilities of the
- 11 boy or girl; and provided, further, that said organization also provides an orientation and training
- 12 program for the boy or girl before he or she begins employment.
