An Act authorizing the Public Employee Retirement Administration Commission to hold hearings.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 9 of Chapter 36 of the Acts of 2012 says that, "In no event shall any member be
2 entitled to a retirement allowance under sections 1 to 28 inclusive, which is based upon a salary
3 that was intentionally concealed from or intentionally misreported to the commonwealth, or any
4 political subdivision, district or authority of the commonwealth, as determined by the
5 commission."

6 This bill further clarifies the Public Employee Retirement Administration Commission's
7 (PERAC's) ability to conduct hearings and investigations related to Chapter 32, Section 15(7)
8 and to provide guidance related to said matters.
