The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Thirteen

An Act promoting fairness in private construction contracts.

Whereas, The deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat its purpose, which is to provide forthwith for certain construction contracts and addendums to pipfitter licenses., therefore, it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public [Emergency Preamble Context].

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 27B of chapter 149 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2008
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the words "public works" in line 2 the
- 3 following words:- "project by an agency, executive office, department, board, commission,
- 4 bureau, division or authority of the commonwealth or county, or municipality or any subdivision
- 5 thereof.".
- 6 SECTION 2. Section 27B of Chapter 149 of the General Laws is hereby further amended
- 7 by inserting after the following word "shall" in line 7:- "submit weekly to the awarding authority
- 8 by mail, first class postage pre-paid, and by electronic mail, certified payroll records that shall
- 9 consist of a complete copy of such records accompanied by a statement signed by the employer

10 11	that indicates (a) such records are correct; and (b) the rate of wages paid to each performing the work of mechanic, apprentice, teamsters, chauffeurs, and laborers, and shall".
