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The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

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**In the Year Two Thousand Thirteen**  
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An Act relative to Workers Compensation Insurance.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1: Chapter 152 of the general laws shall be amended in section five (5) by  
2 inserting at the end thereof the following:-

3 “; provided further, that notwithstanding any general or special law, rule, or regulation to  
4 the contrary, any employer conducting business in the commonwealth for fewer than twenty (20)  
5 days per calendar year which can produce proof of workers compensation insurance considered  
6 valid in any state of the United States of America, shall be deemed to be in compliance with all  
7 requirements relative to the provision of workers compensation insurance in the  
8 commonwealth.”
