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**In the Year Two Thousand Thirteen**  
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An Act relative to clarifying the reporting of record keeping requirements.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1.

2 Section 52C of Chapter 149, as recently amended by section 148 of chapter 240 of the  
3 acts of 2010, is amended at the end of the second paragraph by inserting the following sentence:-  
4 “The term ‘negatively affect’ shall mean the use of the information in question constitutes the  
5 sole basis for determining an employee’s qualification.”
