AN ACT RELATIVE TO FINGERPRINTING.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 1A of chapter 263 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2006 Official
- 2 Edition, is hereby amended, by striking out the section in its entirety and inserting in place thereof the
- 3 following section:-
- 4 Section 1A. Whoever is arrested by virtue of process, arraigned by virtue of an indictment or summons, or
- 5 is taken into custody by an officer, and charged with the commission of any crime shall be fingerprinted,
- 6 according to the system of the department of state police, and may be photographed. One copy of such
- 7 fingerprints and photographs shall be forwarded within a reasonable time to the colonel of state police by
- 8 the person in charge of the police department taking such fingerprints and photographs.
