## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-First General Court (2019-2020)

An Act relative to municipal deposits.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Chapter 44 of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking out Section
- 2 55A and inserting in place thereof the following section:
- 3 Section 55A. A city, town, district of regional school district officer receiving public
- 4 money and lawfully and in good faith and in the exercise of due care depositing the public
- 5 money pursuant to the provisions of Section 55 of Chapter 44 shall not be personally liable to the
- 6 city, town, district or regional school district for any loss of public money by reason of the
- 7 closing or liquidation of any depository institute described in said section.
